

Domestic Terminal Upgrade Project

VEHICLE HEIGHT RESTRICTIONS AT DOMESTIC TERMINAL – MAXIMUM VEHICLE HEIGHT 3.8M

From now until late September 2011, a height restriction of 3.8 metres will apply to all vehicles using the roads in front of the Domestic Terminal at Brisbane Airport.

The height restriction will be in place during the construction of a new pedestrian overpass across the Domestic Terminal face roads.

When the overpass is completed, height clearance will be 4.5 metres.

Public Trucks, Buses And Coaches

- There will be no access to the **roads in front of the Domestic Terminal** for any vehicle higher than 3.8 metres.
- Bus operators not registered with Brisbane Airport Corporation but wishing to set down or pick up passengers must contact **1300 732 240** to make alternative arrangements.

Information for Licensed Ground Transport Operators (GTOs) at Brisbane Airport

- A new location within the Domestic Terminal precinct has been provided for GTO vehicles higher than 3.8 metres for passenger pick-up and drop-off. A separate flyer has been provided showing the new location.

If you are an on-airport business and expecting truck deliveries, please advise your suppliers about the vehicle height restrictions at the Domestic Terminal.

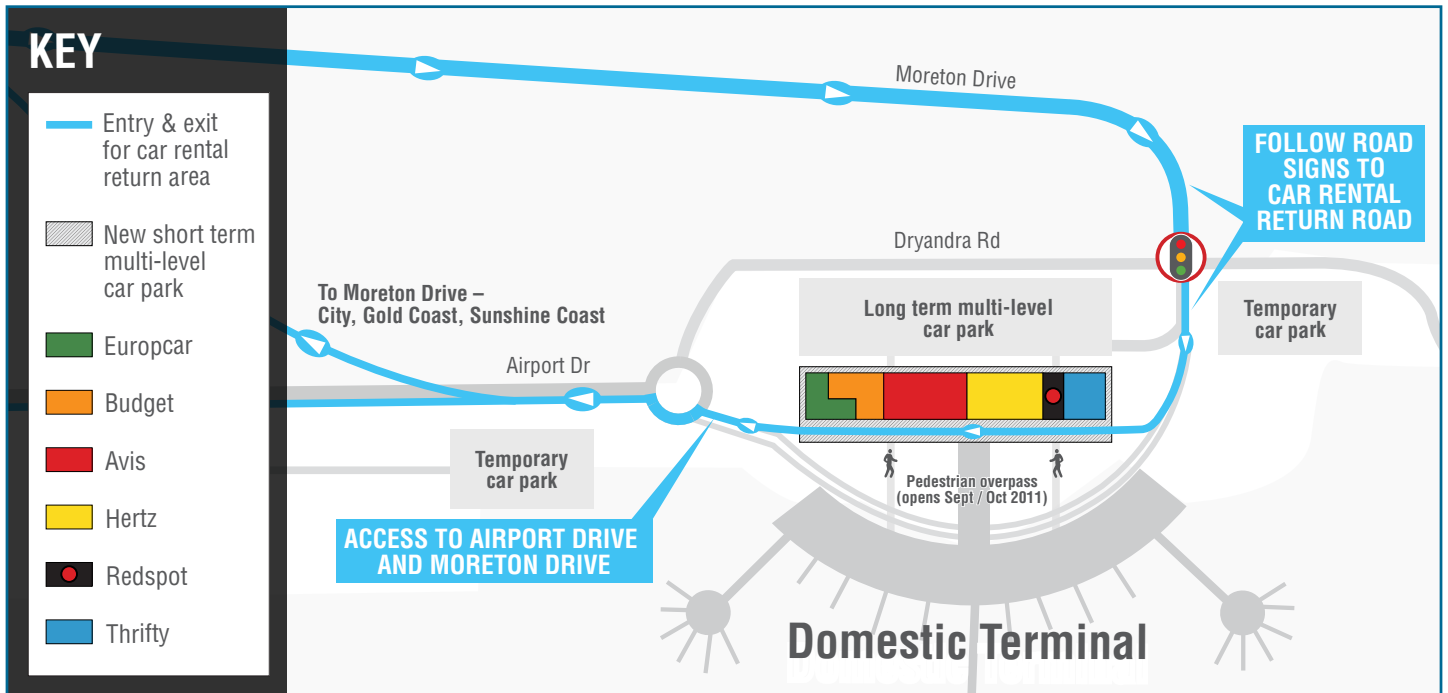


New Multi-Level Car Park (MLCP) at Domestic Terminal

New Location for Car Rental Pick-up and Drop-off

In early June, car rental pick-up and drop-off will move to a permanent location on Level 1 of the new multi-level car park at the Domestic Terminal. See map below for car rental pick-up and drop-off locations.

This marks the completion of stage 1 of construction of the new car park. Public levels of the car park will open progressively from around September this year. Further information about the staged opening of the car park will be included in coming updates.



Floor Numbering System in New Car Park

Floors within the new multi-level car park will be numbered in accordance with international standards, reflecting the numbering system already in use at Brisbane Airport's International Terminal car park.

The on-ground level will be Level 1, moving upwards to Level 2 and so on.

The floor numbering system within the existing multi-level car park at the Domestic Terminal will also change to the same system of numbering once the new car park is open for public parking.

Car Park Construction Progress

Work on the new multi-level car park is progressing well.

On completion it will add a further 5,000 parking bays, bringing the total complement of parking bays in the Domestic Terminal precinct to around 9,000 by the end of this year.

A number of new facilities have been introduced into the existing multi-level car park at the Domestic Terminal and these will be replicated in the new car park, including:

- Convenient access to pay machines in the lift lobbies on every level of the car park, including ground level
- Easy access to face-to-face customer service on the ground floor
- Automated payment options
- Guaranteed undercover parking when pre-booking (this parking is limited so book early to secure a park).

CONVENIENT MULTI-LEVEL CAR PARK PAYMENT OPTIONS

Parking at Brisbane's Domestic Terminal has never been easier.

Option 1: Insert your credit card at the entry gate: no ticket is issued. Then simply put the same credit card in when you exit and press the button for a receipt. You're out with no paper tickets and queues.

Option 2: Collect a paper ticket on entry, pay by cash or credit card at the automatic pay machines on any level of the car park, or pay at the exit boom gate pay machine by first entering your ticket, then your credit card.

Motorcyclists only: on entry collect a paper ticket and present it to the new customer service window on the ground floor.

Work on Airport Drive

Roadwork will be undertaken on Airport Drive during June. The road between the International Terminal Roundabout and the Domestic Terminal Roundabout will be re-surfaced. Repair work, ahead of re-surfacing, has already been undertaken.

This work will be carried out during the day and will involve intermittent single lane closures. There may be a limited number of traffic stoppages of less than a minute to facilitate the safe movement of equipment and workers within the work site. Traffic management and signage will be in place to assist motorists.

Cyclists are encouraged to proceed with caution through the works zone. The speed limit during the works will be 40km/h.

Gateway Upgrade Project

North of the Sir Leo Hielscher Bridges

New Gateway Motorway northbound

Night time lane closures will be in place for asphaltting works on the new Gateway Motorway northbound in the vicinity of the Southern Cross Way off-ramp and Kingsford Smith Drive.

Works will be undertaken in early June between 8pm and 4:30am (weather permitting). Whilst works have been scheduled to cause minimal impacts, motorists travelling north to Kingsford Smith Drive, the Airport and northern suburbs may experience short delays.

Sir Leo Hielscher Bridges Precinct

Eagle Farm to Murarrie: Sir Leo Hielscher Bridge

Intermittent lane closures will be in place for finishing and maintenance works northbound and southbound on the Sir Leo Hielscher Bridges between Kingsford Smith Drive and Lytton Road, including the approaches to and from Southern Cross Way, new Gateway Motorway, Lytton Road and the Port of Brisbane Motorway. Works will be undertaken between 8pm and 4:30am, as required.

Southbound off-ramp to Lytton Road, Murarrie

Night time lane closures and contra-flow will be in place for upgrade works on Lytton Road and off-ramp. Work will be undertaken, between 8pm to 4.30am, as required. Please visit the website: www.gatewayupgradeproject.com.au to view the traffic alert for these works.

PARK GLOBAL TO FLY LOCAL

Avoid delays in the Domestic Terminal precinct – park at the International Terminal and with your valid parking ticket travel free on the orange T-bus to the front door of the Domestic Terminal.

No queues, no diversions and a transfer to the doorstep of either Qantas or Virgin Australia. Choose one of the 1,700 undercover bays and go to the bus stop on Level 2 of the terminal. T-bus runs from 5.10 am to 10.50pm daily, leaving every 20 minutes and every 10 minutes in peak. Parking for seven days is just \$99.
