

TRAFFIC ALERT BRISBANE AIRPORT ROAD NETWORK

A number of significant infrastructure projects are currently under construction either on or near Brisbane Airport. These projects, which are being undertaken by groups including the Queensland Government, Brisbane City Council and Brisbane Airport Corporation, are an essential part of ensuring Brisbane and Brisbane Airport are ready to meet the challenges of regional population growth, increases in international and domestic passengers and growth in the number of people working on and around the Airport.

During the construction period this essential work will affect existing Airport road networks. To keep you informed BAC will issue regular traffic updates on current and future activities that may affect how you move around the Airport precinct.

The projects currently underway are designed to make future travel to and from Brisbane Airport easier. We appreciate your cooperation during the course of these works and recommend that you plan journeys in the knowledge of increased road work and the potential for delays.

CURRENT TRAFFIC UPDATE

1 Airport Drive

Reduction in speed limit – DFO Overpass to International Terminal

From November 2007 until mid 2009, the speed limit in this zone has been reduced to facilitate the construction of the Northern Access Road Project and an overpass for the Gateway Upgrade Project. This reduction reflects the work zone status of the area, an increase in truck movements, and to provide a safer environment for site workers and road users. Road barriers will remain in place for the same period of time.

We encourage motorists to be aware of the reduced speed environment.

Temporary night time lane closures on Airport Drive

From November until April 2008, between the hours of 10pm and 5am, at least one inbound and outbound lane of Airport Drive, in the vicinity of the Lomandra Drive roundabout, will be closed to allow for the construction of the overpass mentioned above. All lanes will remain open during the day.

2 Sugar Mill Road

Sugar Mill Road Upgrade

Early works have started on the conversion of the Sugar Mill Road and Lomandra Drive intersection to a roundabout. Formal construction work is expected to commence early in the New Year.

3 General

Increased Truck Movements

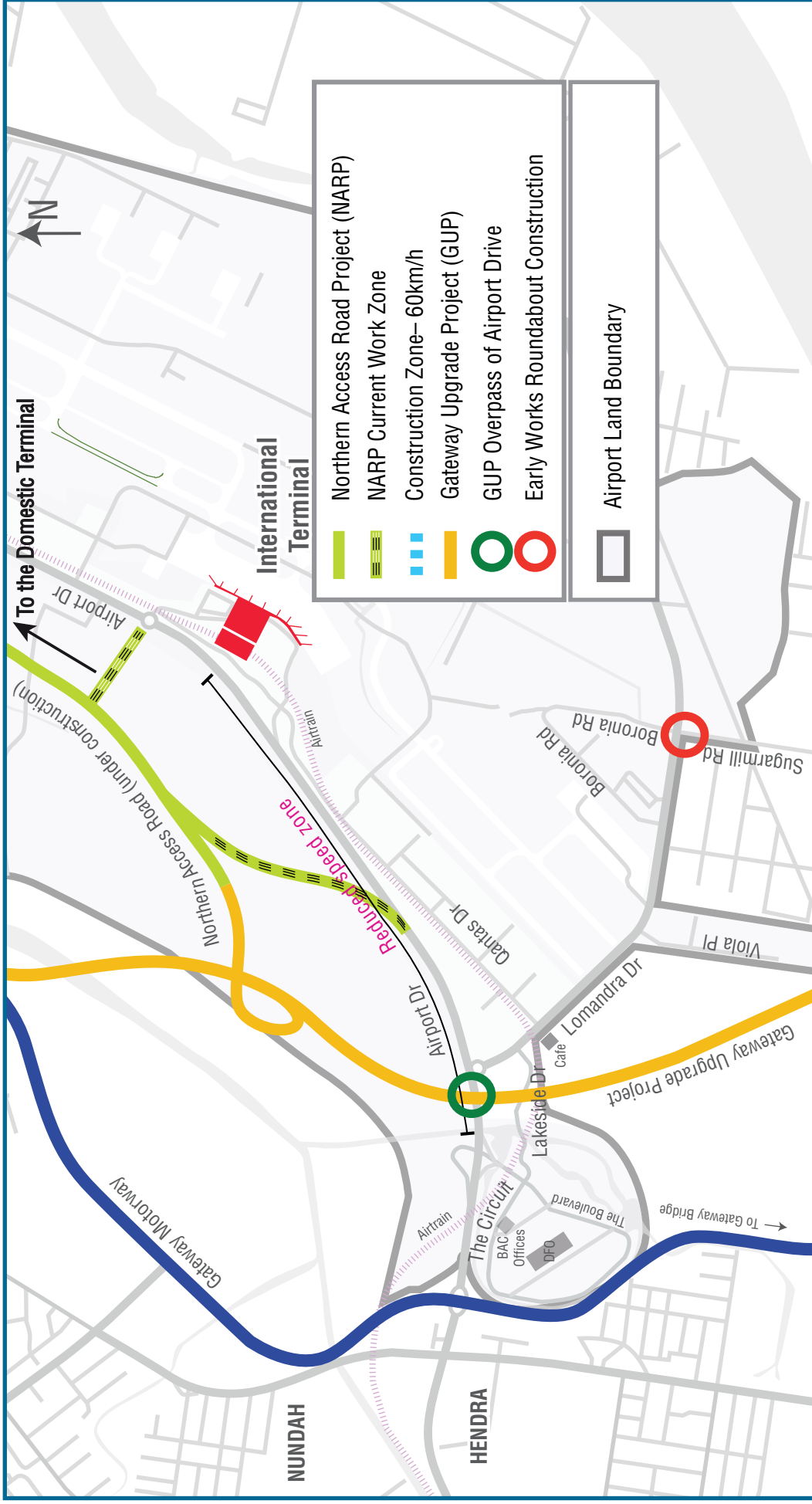
Due to a range of projects being undertaken concurrently there is an increased number of trucks operating in and around Brisbane Airport.

Airport Drive/East West Arterial Signalised Roundabout

The Department of Main Roads has established a taskforce to review the operation of the recently installed traffic signals. Updates will be provided by the Department.



ABOUT CURRENT PROJECTS

Northern Access Road Project (NARP)
 This is a second access for Brisbane Airport and will connect with the new Gateway and the International and Domestic Terminals. It is scheduled for completion in mid 2009.
