

BRISBANE AIRPORT TRANSFER INFORMATION

Arrive Domestic Terminal – transfer to the International Terminal



Step 1: Collect your luggage

After disembarking, proceed to the baggage carousel.



Step 2: Bus from Domestic to the International Terminal

Follow the orange transfer signs to the 'Transfer Bus Stop'. The free bus runs every 10 minutes (between 6am and 7pm) and every 25 minutes (between 7pm and 6am) with the service operating from 4am to 11pm each day.



Step 3: Arrival at the International Terminal

The Transfer Bus arrives at the departure level (Level 4) of the International Terminal. Proceed to check-in.



Step 4: Check-in

Check-in with your airline. Some airlines offer automated check-in kiosks and baggage drops.



Step 5: Departure gate

Proceed to the departure lounge and enjoy your flight.

Transfer options between terminals



Brisbane Airport's International Terminal is located 4KM from Brisbane Airport's Domestic Terminal. There are a variety of options for transferring between terminals including:



Free Airport Transfer Bus

The Airport Transfer Bus is free and runs every 10 minutes (between 6am and 7pm) and every 25 minutes (between 7pm and 6am) with the service operating from 4am to 11pm each day.



Airtrain

Airtrain departs every 15 minutes during peak times between the terminals. Tickets are \$5 per person and can be purchased at the train platform and the Visitor Information Centre.



Taxi

Both International and Domestic Terminals have official taxi ranks conveniently located outside the terminals. Simply follow the 'taxi' signage.
